

REMEMBERING Elizabeth Ban

March 1, 1936 - December 23, 2022



It is with great sadness that the Bán family announces the peaceful passing of Elizabeth Bán after a long battle with dementia.

Elizabeth was born in the town of Hadikfalva (now Dornesti), Romania into a family of Szekley ethnicity. During WWII, her family was forced to relocate to Hungary.

In 1956, her son Attila was born, followed by daughter Zsuzsanna, both with her first husband.

In 1961, Elizabeth graduated as a fully qualified Hungarian nurse with top honours. Several years later, while working at a hospital in Vienna, Austria, she met her future love, Otto, also from Hungary. They moved to Canada in 1968 and eventually settled in the Vancouver area, married and started a family. Enticed by Hungarian friends, they moved to Powell River in 2002 after Otto's retirement.

Elizabeth was predeceased by her son Attila (aged 65), daughter Zsuzsanna (aged 21), and her older brother Jeromos (aged 12). She is survived by her loving husband Otto, her son Thomas (Lauren), granddaughter Hilary, sisters Agota and Marika both still living in Hungary.
